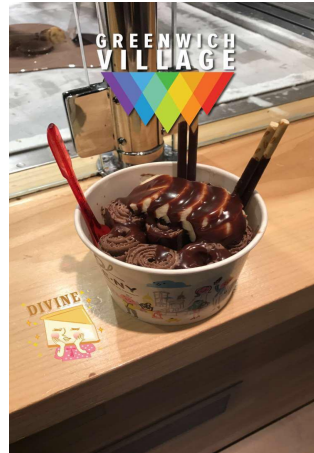

In the multi-purpose room, residents will be able to create fall-themed décor to hang on their wall, using supplies that we will provide.


### Halloween Movie in Lobby
