Point System



Attendance at RHA general body meeting

- 1 point is awarded per individuals who are present

Point System



Awards for Planned Programs

- Recreational Programs are awarded 5 points each
- Educational and Community based program are awarded 10 points each

For Educational and Community programs, Hall RHAs are required to give short presentation explaining and reflecting the program at RHA general body meeting

Point System



Hours of Volunteering for other Halls or campus-wide RHA events (not your own hall!)

- Required to time log volunteer hours and representing halls

Volunteering is counted by 30 minutes intervals. You will be awarded with 1 points for every 30 minutes you volunteer for your hall.
